

# The Diploma in Chinese Herbal Medicine (Dip.CHM)

### **COURSE FEES 2016 ONWARDS**

The Course fee is Euro 3,880 per year, inclusive of Examination fees. This is a yearly fee and no remuneration will be given to a student failing to complete the year.

#### **FIRST YEAR FEE - € 3880**

There is an initial Deposit of €300, which is part of the course fee. This is paid on acceptance to the programme and reserves a place for you.

The remainder of the first year fee (€ 3580) can be paid in a variety of ways:

#### **FEE PAYMENT STRUCTURE:-**

- Payment in full, in advance – the remaining fee is reduced to € 3490.
- Payment in two equal parts (€ 1790 each payment)
  - one before the course commences
  - the other approximately half way through the first year of the course
- Payment in 4 equal parts (€ 918 each payment).
  - one before the course commences
  - the others approximately at quarterly intervals during the first year.

#### **SECOND YEAR FEE - € 3880**

#### **FEE PAYMENT STRUCTURE:-**

- Payment in full, in advance – the fee for the year is reduced to € 3780
- Payment in two equal parts (€ 1940 each payment)
  - one before the course commences
  - the other approximately half way through the second year of the course

- Payment in 4 equal parts (€ 994 each payment).

one before the course commences

the others approximately at quarterly intervals during the second year.

## **PAYMENT METHODS**

**The exact fee payment dates will be given on acceptance to the programme.**

Payment can be made by bank transfer. Bank details will be provided on acceptance to the programme.

Alternatively fees can be paid by Bankers Draft, Postal Order or Cheque – payable to ICTCM. These should be sent by regular, not Registered post.

NOTE: In case of serious financial difficulties it may be possible to arrange a payment plan with more (8) instalments. This needs to be discussed individually at interview.

## **LATE PAYMENT**

Please note that failure to pay fees by the specified dates will incur an additional administrative payment of Euro 70 for each late payment.

If a student is in payment arrears they will NOT be permitted to attend the College until the outstanding payment and late payment fee has been successfully lodged in the College account.

All bar the “normal payment method” are offered exclusively at the discretion of the Financial Director of the ICTCM, and in light of prevailing economic circumstances.
